Godparents are welcome but not required to participate in the service.

Adult Baptism:


Anyone over 13 is encouraged to seek baptism

Preparation for Baptism:

Please complete the Baptism Information Sheet available on our website or from the church office.

The minister will meet with you prior to baptism to discuss the role of faith in your life and encourage reflection on the commitments being made during the baptism service.

Parents/guardians and those presenting themselves for baptism are required to say yes to the required questions. The church reserves the right to refuse baptism if this requirement, in good conscience, cannot be met by the participants.
